1. In the event of overwhelming response, each university will be allowed to enter only **one** team per sport (except for Badminton, a maximum of 2 players for Men's Single and a maximum of 2 pairs of mixed doubles can be entered).
2. All games except football will use referees provided by other teams. For football, we will hire professional referees.

3. There will be a fixed ratio of males to females in certain games. For **Mixed Volleyball**, it will be 4 males and 2 females. For **Ultimate Frisbee**, it will be 3 males and 2 females.

2.0 Venues

There are three main sports facilities in the university, that is the Sports Centre (Main Campus), Cryfield and Westwood (at Kirby Corner Road). Xcel Leisure Centre is a private sports centre in Canley; about 5 minutes drive from campus. The venues for Warwick Games 2011 are:

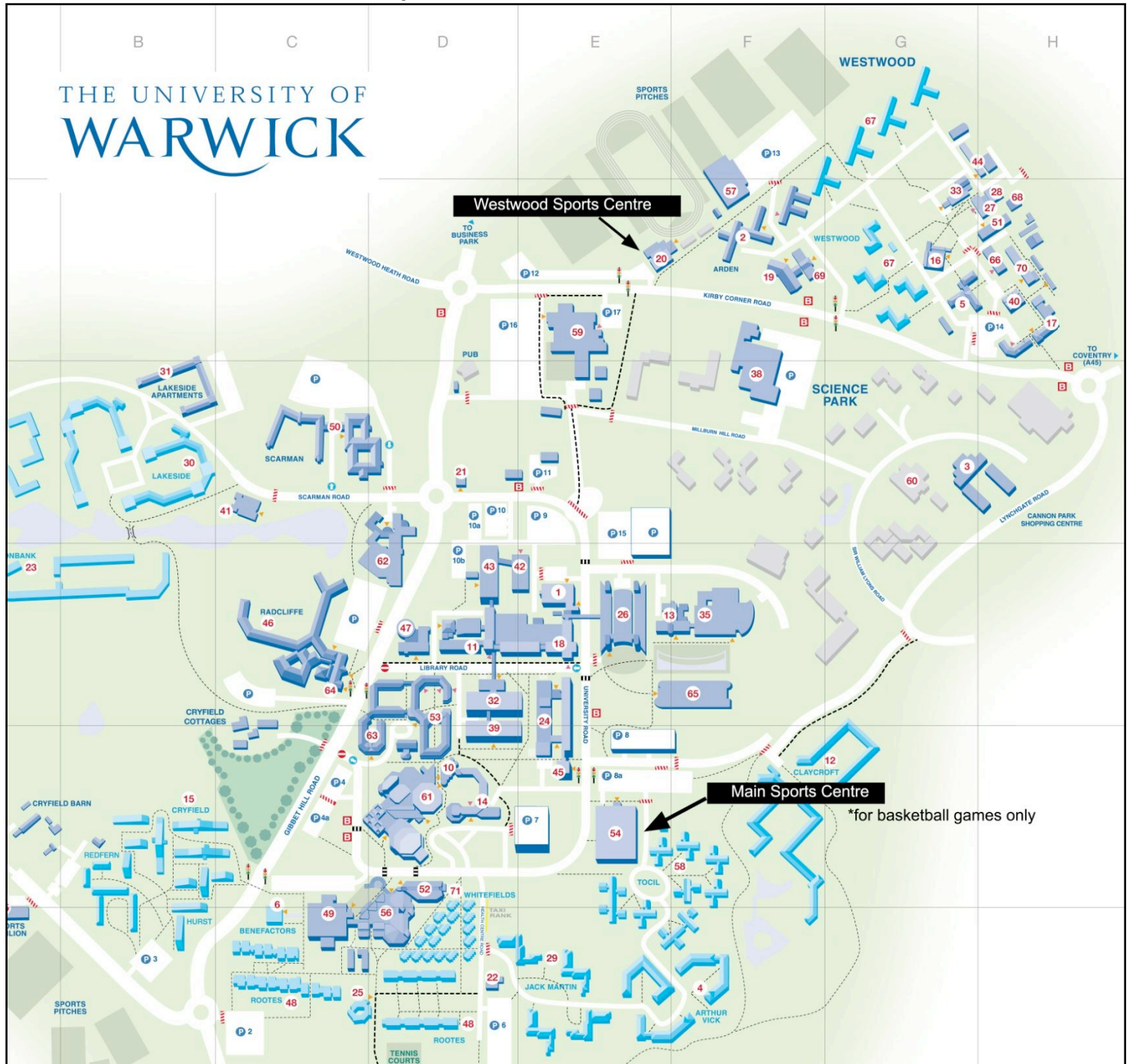

2.1 Getting to University of Warwick

Visitors are encouraged to hire private coaches directly to Warwick. Other options are:

By Rail: **Coventry Rail Station**

Coventry Rail Station is on a direct railway line *London Euston Station - Watford - Milton Keynes - Rugby - Coventry - Birmingham*. For more rail service information visit <http://www.nationalrail.co.uk/>

From Coventry Rail Station, there are frequent local buses to the University. Catch the Travel Coventry **Bus Service 12**, which travels to the main campus. The bus service timetable for the 19th and 20th March is provided in this invitation pack.

By Car

Local Public Bus Transport

Bus number 12 is on the *Coventry Pool Meadow Bus Station - Coventry Railway Station - Warwick University - Kenilworth - Leamington Spa* route. It travels to the campus and stops directly in front of Westwood Sports Centre at Kirby Corner Road. It also stops at the Warwick University Student Union Building as well as the Main Sports Centre.

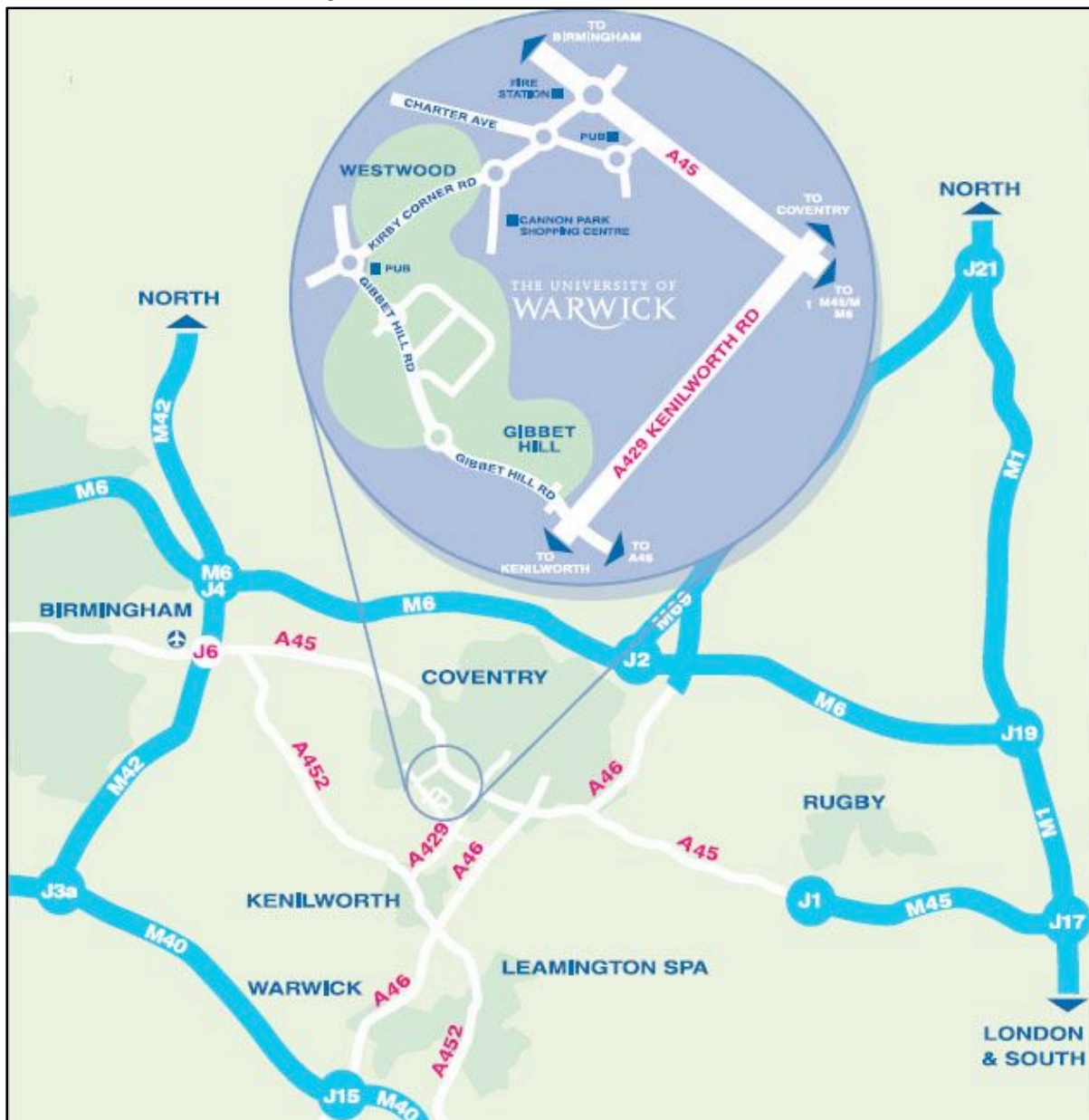

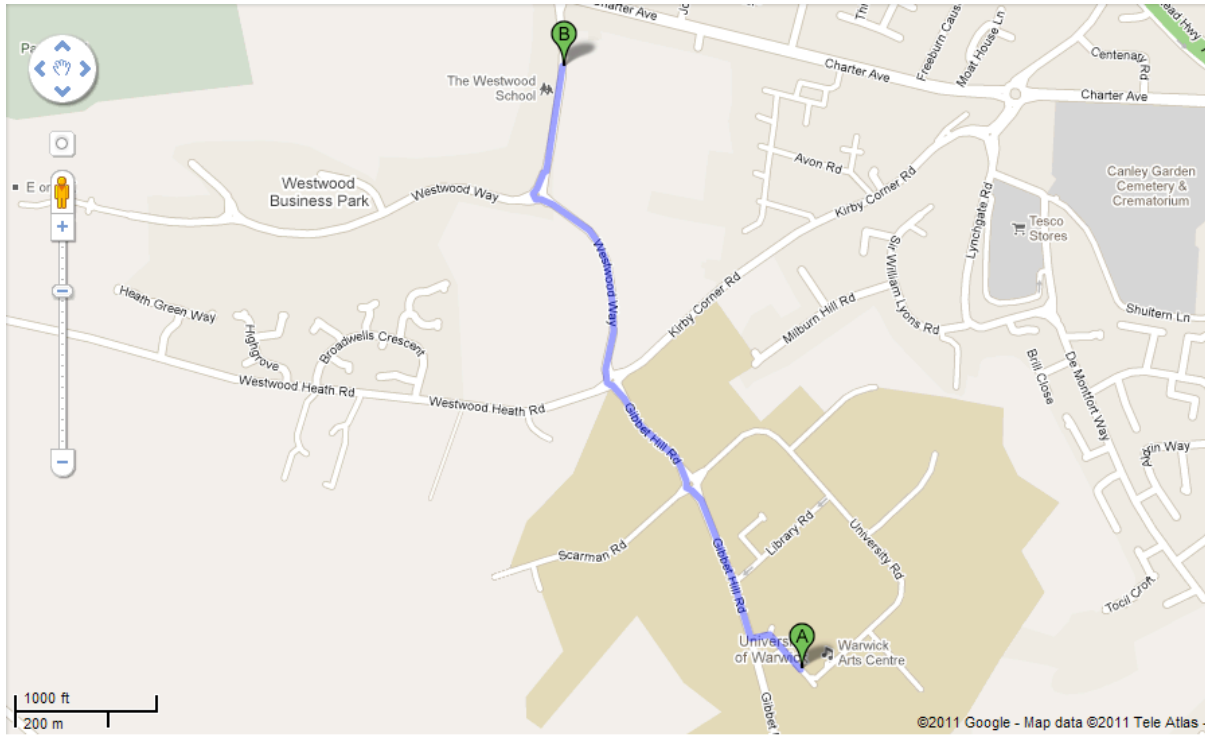

Please take note:-

1. All head of contingents are to first register their attendance at Westwood Games Hall. Registration will open at 08:00.
2. Registration will end strictly at 08:45.
3. Captains are to report to each venue by 8:50.
4. Briefing will be done separately at each venue.
5. Please return to Westwood Games Hall by 18:00 for price giving ceremony.
6. Participants and supporters are allowed to use the lockers in the Westwood Sports Centre for a refundable deposit of £1. All issues relating to this will be handled by the Sports Centre staff.
7. The schedule of the games will be posted on the day itself.
8. Should any fights occur during Warwick Malaysian Games, all players from the university that initiated the fight will be disqualified.

6.0 Frequently Asked Questions

Q1. Are non-Malaysian students allowed to participate in Warwick Malaysian Games 2011?

Players representing the university must be university students and members of their respective society. There will be no discrimination amongst nationality or otherwise.

Q2. Do we have to bring our own equipment?

Yes, please do bring your own balls or racquets for your own practice before a game starts. While we will try to provide a few of each for those who may not have them, having your own equipment is strongly recommended.

Q3. Will you provide bibs to differentiate the teams?

We will only provide bibs for netball. For all other games, please try to colour coordinate your teams.

Q4. Our teams have won a game, what now?

Congratulations! Just chill and relax with some awesome Malaysian food at Westwood Lecture Hall and wait till the closing ceremony starts. We will award trophies or medals for the top 3-teams or individuals of various sports and games.

Q5. How does the refereeing system works?

Except for football, team captains/representatives will take turns to referee games based on fixture provided. A referee is strictly forbidden to ref his/her own university match

Q6. Lunch?

True to Malaysian spirit, there will be booths selling various Malaysian food at the Westwood lecture hall (the first floor of Westwood games hall). All meat is halal and there will be vegetarian options available.

Q7. What if I need more time to confirm?
