

Travelling to Coventry by train

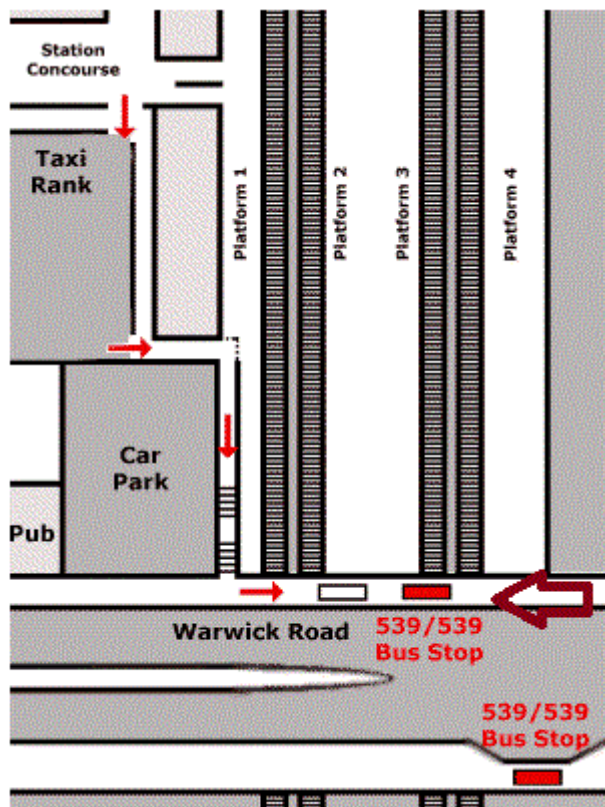
To get to the University by train, please get your tickets to Coventry Train Station. This is the nearest station to the University of Warwick.

If you are travelling from London, tickets can go as low as £ 10 for a return single ticket with a rail card, or about £ 12 for an off peak return option via London Midland. The journey will take about 2 hours and please check if there are any changes along the way. Normally changes occur at Wolverhampton or Nuneaton.

Virgin trains are also a faster option but keep in mind prices will be more expensive than London Midland trains.

If you are travelling to Coventry via Birmingham, the train ride will only take about 20 minutes via Virgin trains and the return ticket to Birmingham will cost about £ 2 to £ 3.

Here are directions from the train station exit to the bus stop:



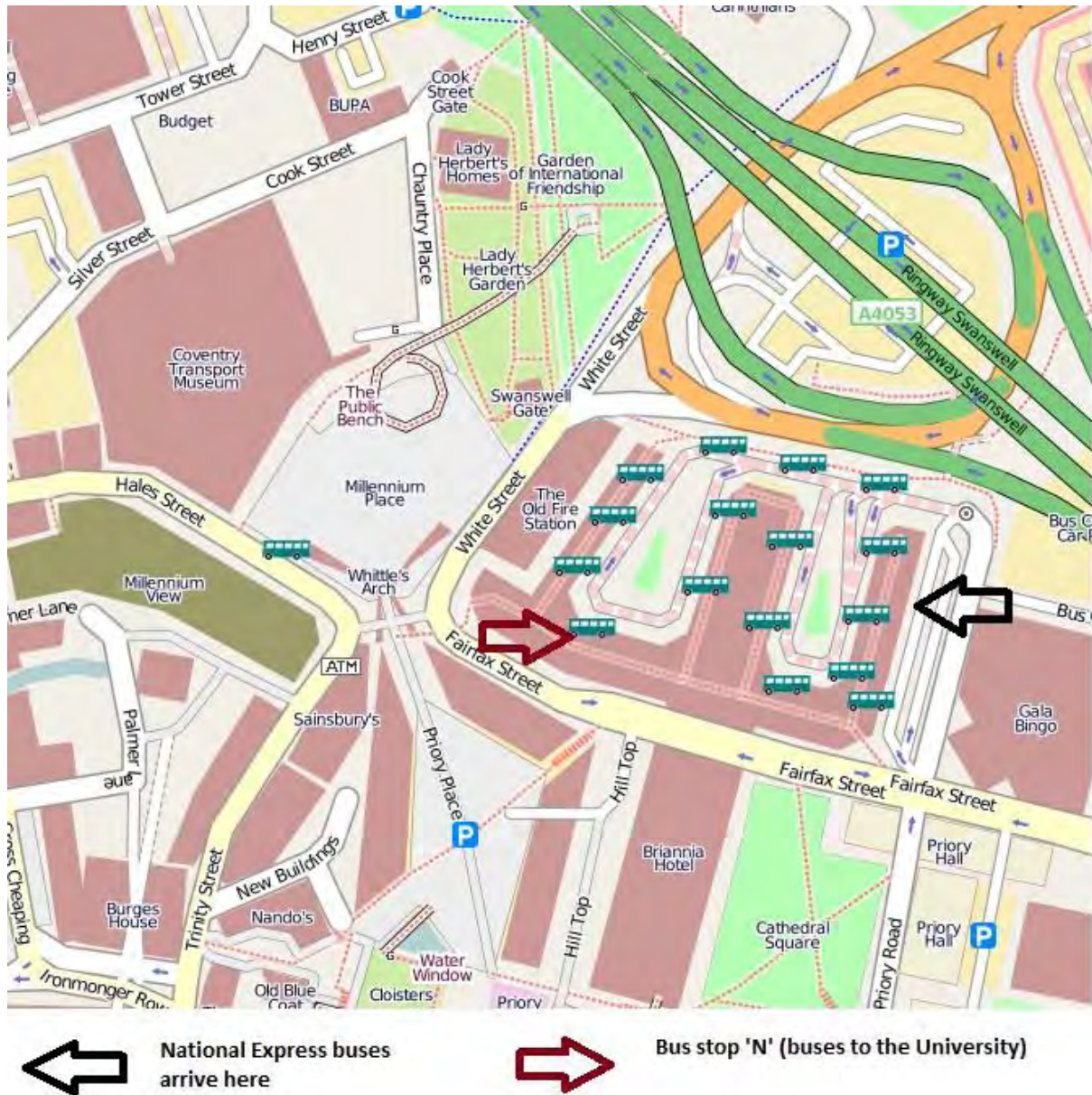
Travelling to Coventry by bus.

If you are travelling to the University of Warwick by bus, there are two different stops.

National Express buses will arrive at Pool Meadow bus station, in which you can easily hop on a local bus to Warwick. When you arrive, please find bus stop 'N' within the bus station and wait for the bus there.

However, if you are travelling by Megabus, you will arrive at Cannon Park Shopping Centre, which is 5 minutes walking distance to the University.

Hopping on the local bus.

From either Pool Meadow bus station or Coventry Rail station, you can take the number 12 bus to get to the University. Simply look out for a Travel Coventry bus, which is easily spotted, with the number 12 that displays 'Leamington Spa' as its destination.

Normally, the bus will display its destination as 'Leamington Spa via University of Warwick/Earsldon'. Journey from the Coventry Pool Meadow bus station will take about 30 minutes to get to the University while from the train station it will take about 20 minutes.

You can get on the same bus to go to Coventry on your way back which displays "Coventry Pool Meadow" as its destination.

Please prepare in advance some coins as the bus will not be giving out any change. A single journey ticket will cost £ 1.60 and an all day ticket is for £ 3.40. If you are travelling in a group of 5, it is best to buy a 'Regional Daysaver 5' daily ticket for £ 7.80 and can be used for all day travelling.



You will find it easy to spot the University banner once you arrive at the University. You can hop off at the bus stop after you pass by Costcutters on your left and the Warwick Arts Centre on your right.
